A collection effort was coordinated in Saipan by Mayor Ramon Camacho, CNMI Corrections Commissioner Anthony Torres and various government and community leaders and has resulted in two (2) 40' containers of various needed items being delivered to Guam tomorrow at 1pm at the Hagat Gym. Officials from Saipan will be here to officially turn over the 2 containers.

Tinian Mayor Edwin Aldan and the Elected Municipal Council donated \$20,000 from their local treasury and personally presented their donation to the Mayors' Council on Tuesday, June 13. Rota Mayor Aubrey Hocog, despite her island sustaining damages from Typhoon Mawar is also coordinating a shipment of supplies to our mayors which will be received soon.
